My work explores the relationship between color and/or multimedia, specifically how color can affect the overall mood of a piece with multimedia. With influences as such as Vicki Tsai and Ilya Kuvshinov, new works are often incorporating some of their stylistic features. When creating portrait art, I often analyze how both artists draw faces. Their style is based on anime and semi-realism which can be seen in some of my other pieces.
